BLAIR ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

CRITERIA FOR JUDGEMENT:

1. Must be a Blair Senior
2. Must Have minimum accumulated GPA of 3.0
3. Student must submit a complete and neat application
4. Students must have Three letters of recommendation from non related people submitted to screening committee
5. Judges should review extracurricular activities, although sports should not be considered too heavily.
6. Judges should review evidence of leadership qualities
7. In general discussion of applicants, judges may concur with Blair alumni members and school faculty to ascertain whether there is a significantly greater need existing on the part of one applicant as opposed to another. (This is to be determined on the basis of informal common knowledge).

This list should be considered in this order arrangement by the judges, that is, as a list of priorities.

Judges should review the letter of application in conjunction with the letters of recommendation. This is a not-renewable scholarship.

JUDGES

1. Two or more impartial Blair Alumni members to be chosen by the Blair Alumni Reunion Committee.
2. All judges must agree.
3. Judges must choose an alternate.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Submit three letters of recommendation.
2. Inform persons making recommendations from non-related people that they must return the letters to the president of the Alumni Association or to the head of the selection committee by April 15
3. The student should inform their people of references of the qualities of activities for which the judges are basing their decision. Some of these qualities could be:
 - a. Honesty
 - b. Good humor
 - c. Lack of substance abuse
 - d. Relates well to others
 - e. Provides leadership
 - f. Exhibits courtesy
 - g. generates admiration from others
 - h. fights for good causes
 - i. works hard
 - j. is prompt
 - k. exhibits good work habits

This list is only a guide and is not intended to limit other comments, nor do all these points have to be reviewed. The candidate's reference people should comment upon the candidates, if known.

The payment will be made to the winning candidate's choice of school.

The scholarship will be applicable to any reputable school, whether trade technical or collegiate.
